In her JP form on file dated May 23rd, 1942, the above Japanese person declared she had two \$5.00 War Savings Certificates in her possession. No action regarding these certificates has been taken by the Custodian.

Life
Insurance:

Yoshino UENOBU declared a Manufacturers Life Insurance Policy, No. 781489, for \$500.00, beneficiary being her daughter, Marie. She stated the policy was in her possession. No action regarding this contract has been taken by the Custodian.

On February 11, 1947 we received a letter from the Prudential Insurance Co. of America advising that they wished to pay the death claim proceeds of \$112.42, plus interest, to Yoshino Uenobu, mother of the insured Kensie Uenobu who died in Japan on December 6, 1943. Accordingly, after paying a claim lodged against Mrs. Uenobu by Peace Cleaners, payment being made in accordance with Mrs. Uenobu's request in a letter on file dated March 17, 1947, the balance of the insurance proceeds are being forwarded to Yoshino Uenobu as per requisition of March 19, 1947.

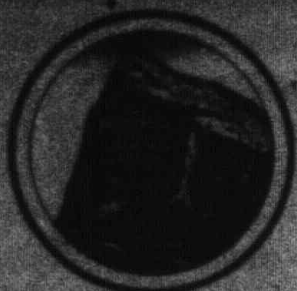

We have for acknowledgement your letter of March 17th and now enclose Custodian cheque in the sum of \$107.35, representing the balance of the death claim proceeds under The Prudential Insurance Company Policy No. 101,274,376, covering on the life of your son, Kensie UENOBU, who died in Japan on December 6th, 1943.

As advised you in our letter of March 11th, the amount of the cheque received from the above insurance company was \$120.95 and as requested by you in your letter to us of March 17th we have transferred the sum of \$13.60 to the account of Hachiro MIYAZAWA in settlement of the claim lodged against you by Peace Cleaners in May 1942, thus leaving a balance of \$107.35 in your account with the Custodian, the amount of the cheque now enclosed.

As your file reveals that no other assets belonging to you came under the control of the Custodian we are now closing your file and account.
