Life Insurance:

Yoshino UENOBU declared a Manufacturers life Insurance Policy, No. 781489, for \$500.00, beneficiary being her daughter, Marie. She stated the policy was in her possession. No action regarding this contract has been taken by the Custodian.

On February 11, 1947 we received a letter from the Prudential Insurance Co. of America advising that they wished to pay the death claim proceeds of \$112.42, plus interest, to Yoshino Benobu, mother of the insured Kenzie Benobu who died in Japan on December 6, 1943. Accordingly, after paying a claim lodged against Mrs. Benobu by Peace Cleaners, payment being made in accordance with Mrs. Benobu's request in a letter on file dated March 17, 1947, the balance of the insurance proceeds are being forwarded to Yoshino Benobu as per requisition of March 19, 1947.
