Your letter inquiring about your chattels has been received. In reply we wish to inform you that a carton identified as your property and containing records, is in storage at Custodian warehouse, Vancouver. This carton will be shipped to you if you so desire.

Your gramophone and other chattels identified as yours remaining at Cumberland in December, 1944, were sold for the net sum of \$23.89 which has been credited to your account.

The Victory Bond and life insurance policy which you declared did not come under the control of this office.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian and in order that you may confirm this we enclose a stamped addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

March 15, 1946.

Re: Takeo GYOBA, Registration No. 07062

X In his declaration to the Custodian this man reported quite a quantity of furniture and personal effects left at Fanny Bay. A number of articles were shipped to this man and his wife in May and June, 1942. The remainder were stored at the Community Hall, Royston Lumber Co., Cumberland, B.C.

In December, 1942, this man signed a list of the articles stored, confirming that these represented all his chattels remaining in the protected area. On April 10th he signed a Custodian release requesting shipment of 4 boxes which we understand were shipped as requested. The balance of his goods were sold at auction for the net sum of \$23.89, with the exception of 1 carton which is in storage at 604 Cordova St. According to Mr. Wills the carton in storage contains records. *Sued May 3/46 for 8 cents. Gu.*

This man reported a \$50.00 Victory Bond and a Monarch Life insurance policy. Neither of these items came under the control of the Custodian.

This file reveals no other property of any kind. The file of this man's wife, file 7453, shows that she declared ownership of no property. The personal property of this family is dealt with entirely in file 9995.

This summary is certified to be in accordance with information on file.

On an undated JP form signed by Mrs. T. GIUSA, there appears a list of chattels numbered 1 to 18. This JP form is made out in the name of Takeo GIUSA and is carried in File 9995.

On October 16, 1942, Mr. Matt Brown, reported that Nos. 2-6-18-19 had been shipped on May 26, 1942. That on June 24, 1942, Nos. 7-13-14-15 had been shipped. Mr. Brown listed the items still on hand, and this list was sent to Takeo GIUSA, who on December 1, 1942, confirmed that the articles listed were all the chattels belonging to him remaining in the protected area.

In Custodian Release dated April 10, 1943, he requested shipment of the following:

Box #1 - hand-saws, axe, etc. garden tools
Box #9 - kitchenware, china
Box #12 - food
Box #17 - wash boiler effects

May 13/43*

On December 13, 1944, we sold at auction the following:

No. 3 - gramophone
No. 4 & 5 - 2 Stone crocks
Nos. 14, 15, 16, inventoried as 3 sets bed ends, 1 set bed rails, 2 bed-springs
sold as 2 double beds.
Another No. 16 - a child's crib.
No. 2 - cross-cut saw - sold as 2 saws
No. 8 - Kitchen range.

On May 3, 1946, there were some records sold in Vancouver. These were the contents of a carton of effects received from Cumberland, and appear to be the carton shown as No. 1 on the inventory of October 16, 1942.

This would appear to account for everything, but on July 24, 1946, GIUSA asked about all the items listed on the inventory signed by him on December 1, 1942. If he has no record of Boxes Nos. 1, 9, 12 & 17, it would seem that these could not have been shipped as he requested in Release of April 10, 1943. This is being investigated.
