

Which has been duly registered with the Custodian in Vancouver, prior to our evacuation, along with other articles, namely, 5 H.P. Palmer engine net lines and other things.

According to the information received from a friend at Wadhams, B. C., all of the above mentioned stored goods were destroyed by fire of last summer when the cannery got burnt down.

These Cohoe nets has been insured at \$100.00 each against fire losses, on October 3rd 1941.

Your advise as to what step we should take in order to collect this insurance, would be greatly appreciated. As we were unabled to get any reply from the B. C. Packers Limited in this connection.
