This file reveals no claims against Mrs. YAMAMOTO. There is however a claim on the file of her husband in the sum of \$131.50 owing by YAMAMOTO to Kawajima-KANEDA, File 11794. YAMAMOTO has admitted this claim but in his letter of March 23/44 he stated that he has talked this matter over with Mr. KANEDA and told him that he could not pay this debt until after the war. He advised that KANEDA agreed to this. He advised further of this in our letter of March 23/44 and told him that we would have this amount to be settled between them.

This file reveals that Mrs. YAMAMOTO owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: Mrs. YAMAMOTO registered with the Custodian on May 23/42 and was evacuated on June 22/42. She signed a yellow "No property" card stating that she owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of B.C.

However chattels were found in her name at her home, 1618 W. 2nd Ave. on Sept. 18/42. A list of these was sent to her and she confirmed this list as being all the chattels she left in the protected area. Most of the items on this list were declared by Mr. Masaharu YAMAMOTO, with the addition of some other chattels. These are listed on Chattel Schedule on file.

With the exception of the shipment of one single bed, one double bed and one kitchen stove made to Mr. YAMAMOTO, and one table discarded, the balance of chattels on the list were sold at auction for the net sum of \$10.19. A carton of Japanese lanterns not inventoried is included in this auction.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

Mr. YAMAMOTO declared all the articles listed above with the exception of the chairs and the kitchen cupboard, and added the following as well.

These were not found by the Custodian. It is more than likely that the trunk of clothing would be taken with them at the time of their evacuation. It is also quite probable that the carpenter tools, kitchen utensils and Singer sewing machine were taken. It is doubtful if the oil stove would be taken as stoves were usually supplied in houses of the Interior Settlements and YAMAMOTO first lived at Sandon after leaving the Coast.

Dear Madam:

Although you declared no property of any kind left in the protected area when you registered with the Custodian, some chattels were found in your name at 1618 West 2nd Avenue. We sent you a list of these which you signed and returned, agreeing that these were all the chattels left by you in the protected area.

On June 3rd, 1943, your husband requested shipment of one double bed, one single bed and one kitchen stove, and these were handed over to the B. G. Security Commission for shipment on July 9, 1943.

The balance of saleable chattels were sold at auction for the net sum of \$10.19 and this sum credited to your account with the Custodian.

As the Custodian has no further assets or property of any kind belonging to you under his control, we are now closing your account and your file.
