Dear Madam: Re: Yoshivuki UEO (Dec'd)

This is merely to put on record that in line with the Letters of Administration issued to your husband, Mr. Kosaburo UEO, to your late son, from the amount standing in your son's account from the sale of his car, namely \$377.77, \$100.00 was forwarded to Mr. Kosaburo UEO in November 1943, and a further \$100.00 in December 1943. He has now requested us to forward him the balance of the account, and a further cheque for \$171.77 is being despatched to him in the course of the next day or two which will thus make a total of \$371.77. The remaining \$6.00 is being retained by us in the meantime in view of a claim, we believe, against your late son by the Union Oil Company of Canada and about which we have written to your husband.

As stated above, this letter is only to put on record and advise you of the disbursements made from your late son's account.
