The doctor was in Vancouver for about 10 days during which period he effected many shipments to his friends up country, and no doubt the chattels declared by Mrs. AKUNE were disposed of during that period, as they were not included in the auction which took place at 210 Powell St.

The file reveals Mrs. AKUNE owned no specified articles.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
