Alot of undeclared and unlisted personal property at 1001 and 1005 Denman St. was disclosed by Kyumatsu MORI in his letter of March 22/45 at which time he requested shipment of the following:

l tailors iron several floral arrangements equipment Christmas decorations l empty golf bag 3 Japanese screens

l electric vacuum cleaner l electric wall clock 1 box containing wedding vell 1000-1500 paper bags

l electric record player The B.C.S.C. in their letter of May 2/45 expressed disapproval of shipment of anything except purely personal goods. A shipment of 1 box of personal effects and a crate of screens was made to MORI at New Denver on May 29/45 Most of the other articles asked for in his letter were sold at auction as noted on Chattel Schedule. The total net amount received from auctions was \$134.57, not including the \$60.46 received from sale of the sewing machine at auction.

The amount received from counter and showcases sold to Campbell Bros. was \$175,25.

The amount received from Campbell Bros. for rent of the equipment was \$239.50, less the commission of 5% paid to our agent H.D. Campbell ..

Two cheques, one for \$30.00 and one for \$500.00 were sent to Mrs. MORI from the account of Mr. MORI. An account of \$8.36 was paid to the B.C. Telephone Co. from this account and also back income tax owing by Mr. Moki in the sum of \$48.55 was paid from his credit balance with the Custodian. The cost to have the press appraised was \$5.00 and this was paid from the account of the above, and the cost for shipping personal goods to him was \$8.10, which sum was also deducted from his account.

Toshio MORI, File 3285, a brother-in-law of Mr. MORI, in his letter of March 29/46, requested the transfer of \$329.50 from his account to the account of Mrs. MORI in payment of moneys owing to her. As his credit balance with us was only \$321.00, this amount only was transferred to her account.

The above declared a savings account in the Royal Bank of Canada, Georgia and Denman Sts., in the sum of \$300.00. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

Three policies were declared, one with the Yorkshire Company in the sum of \$3000.00, one with the Monarch Life in the sum of \$1000.00, and two with the Sum Life Co. each for \$2000.00 In his letter of July 3/46 MoR1 requested us to pay the Sum Life Co. the sum of \$639.74 in order to bring his account up to date. In his letter of July 31/46 Mr MoRI requested us to pay the Monarch Life Co. the sum of \$81.70 to bring this account up to date. As he has only a belance of \$646.77, both of these accounts cannot be paid.
