GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: IMAMURA, Shintaro - Reg.No.07577

A Claim for \$49.77 was lodged with this office against IMAMURA by Kikujiro TANAKA, New Fish Market. Two letters were written to IMAMURA about the debt but no reply was received. TANAKA was so informed and advised to communicate with IMAMURA direct at Sandon, B.C.

When registering with the Custodian the above Japanese declared logging equipment which was to be left in the care of the manager of the Stave Lake Cedar Co., Dewdney, B.C. According to a letter dated June 25th, 1942 the Stave Lake Cedar Company reported that this equipment had been taken by IMAMURA when he was evacuated. A letter from the Assistant Supervisor at Sandon, B.C. reveals that the logging equipment and personal property were all brought to Sandon and were being used on a logging project.

This file reveals no assets or liabilities brought under control by the Custodian and requires no further administration.

The file may now be closed.
