

GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Rokuro NISHI, Reg. No. D6960

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 27, 1942. He was evacuated on June 13, 1942.

In his declaration he reported logging equipment at Slave Lake Cedar Co., Suicide Creek, B. C. The Slave Lake Cedar Co. informed this office that the equipment had been taken away by NISHI before his evacuation, and this information was sent to NISHI on June 26, 1942. As he did not reply it would appear that he had taken this equipment away as reported.

He reported a \$50.00 Victory Bond in his own possession. This did not come under the control of this office.

The bank account in the Royal Bank of Canada, Main & Hastings, which he reported, did not come under the control of this office.

He reported a Manufacturers Life Insurance Co. policy. This office has signed the application for cash surrender of this policy, \$514,446, on behalf of the beneficiary, Yoshino NISHI who is in Japan, and the cheque in settlement of claims under this policy, in the amount of \$253.00 has been handed to Mr. Good for release to Rokuro NISHI.
