MEMORANDUM

Re: Mr. Isuro SATO, Registration
No. 07392, Deceased.

Mr. R. F. Macnoughton, Barrister and Solicitor,
225 Seymour Street, Vancouver, telephoned today and stated that
the above-named had a policy in Union Home Security Association,
for which Association he is the Solicitor.

He further stated that Mr. Sato died of cancer
approximately three weeks after said policy had been written on
his life. Also, the deceased made no mention of this condition in
his application for insurance coverage.

Mr. Macnoughton wished to know whether or not it would
be in order for him to deal direct with the beneficiary, Mr. Ken
Sato, File No. 10150, regarding this matter and we replied that we
had no objection to his doing so, but copies of correspondence should
be forwarded to this Office in order that our file would be complete.
He agreed to keep us informed.
