This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 29, 1942 in which he reported that he owned no property of any kind in the protected area.

However, the records of the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee show that this man was the owner of a vessel "Y.F." which was sold and the net proceeds of \$641.00 were paid to FUKAYE on April 8, 1942.

The Arrandale Cannery purchased a shore boat belonging to this man and the amount of \$15.00 was credited to this man's account. We are remitting this amount to him today.

MEMORANDUM TO ACCOUNTING DEPT.

July 5, 1943

Re: Files Nos. 1536, 11521 & 10168

On June 25, 1942 Arrandale Cannery purchased nets and boats to the value of \$129.85 belonging to various Japanese fishermen.

Among these was: Yoshimatsu FUKAE - Shore boat \$15.00

This was originally credited to Yoshimatsu FUKAE, File #11521, but was later transferred to Yoshimatsu MUKAI, File #1536.

I think this should be credited to Yoshimatsu FUKAYE, whose name was sometimes spelled "FUKAI", and who was employed by Arrandale Cannery, fishing license #1060.
