There is this further condition, that the personal effects of the former minister, Rev. K. Nomoto, which are now stored in the building will remain there in one of the rooms, and that the furnishings belonging to the Church will also have storage in the building. Further, it is undestood that I shall have access to the building whenever it may be necessary, but before making any visit to the building I would communicate with you. If you will draw up the necessary document, giving effect to the above agreement and conditions, and send it to me, I shall sign it and return it to you. 

On July 6th, 1944 you were good enough to provide us with the Consent of the Custodian to the appointment of Kiku Nomoto as Administratrix of the above noted Estate and to the distribution of the Estate in accordance with the law of the Province of British Columbia. We presume that we are also obliged to clear the matter again with you and to ask for the consent of the Custodian to the appointment of the Official Administrator for the County of Vancouver as Administrator of this Estate and for distribution of the proceeds of the Estate in accordance with the laws of the Province of British Columbia.


