Hisaye IWAMOTO died at New Denver, B. C. On December 12, 1946, at the age of 25 years. She is survived by her mother, Yuri, file #10268; four brothers, Kazuo, file #1760, Iwao, file #10270, Satoru, file #12767, and Yoshio, a minor; and one sister, Momoyo, a minor.

The only assets declared by the deceased were a small quantity of chattels which were left at 220 Pembina Street. These items were sold with goods declared by Kazuo IWAMOTO, who was the registered owner of this property, and the funds derived credited to his account. These funds have now been forwarded to Kazuo IWAMOTO and in view of the very small value of the items involved, no effort is being made to recover this portion of the funds.

The only claim filed against the deceased is for the sum of \$80.00 to cover funeral expenses paid by the Department of Labour. They are today being advised that no funds are available from which to pay the claim.
