

Dear Sir: You will remember that at Hastings Park on June 1st, you declared no personal property in the Protected Ares of British Columbia but that later, on June 22nd, 1943 you wrote to us from Greenwood that you had left a gill net valued at \$50.00 at Goose Bay Connery, hiver's Inlet. Have you since made any arrangements for the sale of this net? If you have not, we will make inquires on your behalf, if you will let us know to whom we should write in this cannery. In this connection, however, we believe that this cannery will now be closed down for the winter and there will be no chance of selling this net until next sesson. It will then be two sessons older then when you left the coast and if we assume that \$50.00 was the value then it will now have depreciated considerably. Under these circumstances we do not believe that it is worth pursuing this matter any further and unless we hear from you to the contrary we will assume that there is nothing more the Custodian has to do for you.
