GENERAL MEMORANDUM

No JP declaration form is attached to this file but a Form J card was signed by the above Japanese person under date of June 1st, 1942, certifying that he had no property of any kind in any protected area of British Columbia.

This file reveals, however, that Kenji Hori has a Sun Life ^{*}Assurance Company policy, premiums on which are being paid by Mrs. Sumi Hori (mother), and according to Mrs. Hori's file (No. 12704) it is found that she is also taking care of the premiums on a Metropolitan Life Insurance Company policy in Kenji Hori's name.

The only funds shown in the above Evacuee's account were in the amount of \$10.63, which funds were forwarded to Kenji and the account closed.

No claims against the above Japanese person are revealed on this file, which is now being closed.

NO OTHER PROPERTY, REAL OR PERSONAL, OF THE ABOVE JAPANESE PERSON IS FOUND ON THIS FILE.


