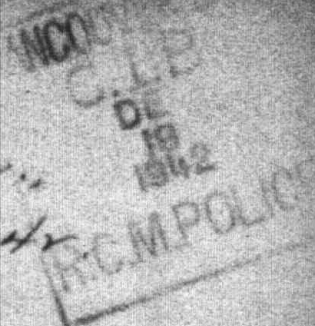

Dear Sir:

We are in receipt of your letter of February 21st and would suggest that you take up with Norris & MacLennan the matter of the missing tools from the B. C. Purchasers' Warehouse. We understand that this place was broken into and a large amount of the goods stored there were stolen.

As requested, we have asked our Protection Department to arrange for the sale of your Japanese festival dolls. They have, however, called our attention to the fact that these dolls do not bring a very good price at auction. If you would prefer to have them shipped to you, kindly advise us.

In regard to your daughter's radio, this has been sold for \$37.00, less auctioneer's fees, advertising, moving and storage charges of \$5.45, and her account has been credited with the proceeds of \$31.55, which amount is available to her on the return to us of the R.C.M.P. receipt.

We are today referring your request for a monthly remittance of \$30.00 to the B. C. Security Commission.
