GENERAL SUMMARY

Kinosuke OHARA died at Slocan on September 24, 1942. He is survived by his widow, Noye, file 5775, from whom he was separated; four sons, Isomu, file 14770, Minoru, file #14777, Masaru, file #5290, and Yutaka, a minor; and one daughter, Kimiye, file #1872.

The deceased declared no assets to the Custodian and none are revealed on the file.

A claim in the sum of 20¢ was filed against OHARA by the M. Furuya Company but, due to the small amount of the claim, no action was taken by the Claims Department. The B. C. Security Commission filed a claim for recovery of the sum of \$50.00 from the Estate of the deceased to cover funeral expenses paid by the Commission for his burial. They were advised by this office that the deceased had no assets of which we had knowledge but they were given the addresses of two of the deceased's sons in order that they might endeavour to arrange payment of the funeral claim with them direct.

No claims, other than those mentioned above, appear on this file.
