GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Fusayo TAKEDA, Reg. No. 08995

On June 1, 1942, this woman signed a declaration to the Custodian stating that she owned no property of any kind whatsoever in the protected area.

On May 21, 1942, a shipment of household effects weighing 950 pounds was received from Woodfibre in the name of "Mrs. TAKEDA #08895". A list of these goods was sent to Mrs. Fusayo TAKEDA on May 25, 1942, and on September 9, 1942, she signed confirming that these were all the property she had in the protected area. At various auctions held in Vancouver goods which appears to be that received in the shipment of May 21, 1942, together with some additional goods, was sold and the proceeds were credited to the account of Fusayo TAKEDA. However, since Mrs. TAKEDA had stated that she owned no property, in her original declaration, we are transferring all the funds from the sale of these chattels to Chattel Suspense Account.

A list of the goods contained in the shipment from Woodfibre and of those sold in the name of this woman is filed behind this Summary.
