September 17th, 1946, of the death of the above named Japanese
person.

In the event of funeral costs having been
incurred by your Department, please be informed that this
office has no knowledge of any property of any kind left in
the Protected Area by this man, and in addition the files
of both parents have been reviewed and neither of them own
any assets with the exception of the father, who has a credit
of \$4.80. As this man appears on the list of those who have
applied for repatriation to Japan, this office is already
committed to the Treasury Department in this sum.
