Hatsuko NITTA died at Montreal on November 9, 1946 . She is survived by her husband, Kitaro, File # 11745, a minor son, and her mother, Chieno, file #1692.

Hatsuko NITTA left her husband approximately seven years ago and has since been known by the name of Jean KUROYAMA. Her son remained with his father, Kitaro Nitta.

The only asset declared by the deceased was an insurance policy #1291219, in the Occidental Life Insurance Company, under which her mother is the beneficiary. According to information received from the Occidental Life Insurance Company, this policy is still in force and no claim has been made. In view of the fact that the deceased was indebted to the Department of Labour for hospitalization, they have been advised of the existence of this policy.

A cheque for \$8.00 was received from the Department of Labour for redemption of War Savings Certificate belonging to Hatsuko NITTA, with an authorization signed "Jean Kuroyama", requesting us to pay this sum to the Department of Labour to reimburse the Department for an advance made to her by the Montreal Placement Officer. This payment is being made today.

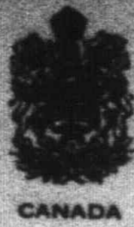


