Dear Sir:

RE: Estate of Yokichi Aihoshi

We have been requested to look after the affairs of the above noted deceased who died intestate at Tashme, B. C. on October 18th.

It will be necessary of course to request both from you and from the Provincial Treasurer that the Official Administrator for the City of Vancouver, British Columbia be requested to apply for administration of the Estate. We are instructed that the deceased died leaving a wife Fujino Aihoshi, who resides at Bay Farm, Slokan. The daughter, Yasuko Aihoshi is a minor and resides in Japan. The deceased wrote a letter before his death expressing the desire that the whole of his estate should go to his daughter. This letter of course is not testamentary. We understand that the wife was separated from her husband at the date of his death and that she may be willing to renounce and release her rights to any of the estate which would go to her under the Administration Act, provided that by so doing the whole estate would go to the daughter.

We would appreciate being advised as to whether if the wife renounces her interest in the estate, or assigns the same to her daughter, the daughter would obtain any benefit thereby. If she would obtain benefit, then we presume that we would require your official consent to the wife making such renunciation and would request the same.
