PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Daisy Yachiro USHIJIMA, Reg. No. 02739

This woman signed a declaration on June 3, 1942, in which she stated that she owned no property of any kind in the protected area. On October 27, 1943, we forwarded to this woman the sum of \$9.10 from her father's account at his request.

Our camera records show the camera, described in the Specified Articles Memorandum, as the property of this woman but this appears to have been an error as this camera, according to the R.C.M.P. report dated April 27, 1943, was surrendered by her brother, Takeshi USHIJIMA, Reg. No. 10320, file 2082, and this camera was released to the B. C. Security Commission by the R.C.M.P. on that date for shipment to Takeshi USHIJIMA.

The radio surrendered on behalf of this woman was sold by the Custodian for the net sum of \$20.74 which was credited to her account and for which she has sent us the R.C.M.P. receipt.

This file reveals no other property.
