In reply to your notice of July 13th, we have communicated with Dr. W. F. Seyer, University of British Columbia, whose reply is as follows:

" I was somewhat surprised to receive the statement submitted by Shaw Mizuhara. He has no authorization whatever to collect the amount stated from you.

It is true that from time to time he assisted me in the laboratory but he was paid regularly except for a few minor items which are still to come in. He graduated a year ago but because he could not get any regular engineering work we felt rather sorry for him, and I got him odd tasks to do from time to time, and he has been paid regularly. How he gets this I do not understand, and it seems a piece of impertinence to ask for it on his part. In any case he has no dealings with the Board but he should deal directly with me."
