PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

An extract on file from the Canadian Credit Men's Trust Association Ltd. dated May 22/42 states that Toyoshi KAWATA, who operated a grocery known as the "Corner Grocery" sold the equipment and fixtures of this grocery to Chung Jan Tai for the sum of \$700.00. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

CHATELS:

KAWATA was evacuated on May 28/42 but did not register until Nov. 7/42. He signed a yellow "No property" card stating that he owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of B. C.

SPECIFIED  
ARTICLES:

According to information supplied to this office KAWATA surrendered a Spartan Console radio to the R.C.M.P. on Mar. 10/42. They handed this over to the Custodian on Dec. 17/43. It was sold at auction for the net sum of \$62.22 and this sum credited to his account with the Custodian. This is his only credit with this office.

SHARES:

An extract from the West Coast Trading Co. Ltd. file states that Toyoshi KAWATA owns 18 shares in that Company. On checking the Company file his name appears on the list of shareholders and the number of shares is correct. He was one of the Directors of this Company in Nov. 1942. This Company is being looked after by P. S. Ross and Sons.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

DECLARATION AS TO LOST RADIO RECEIPT

I, Toyoshi KAWATA, of Winto Mine, B.C., do hereby declare:

That I owned a Sparton Console radio, Model 98, Serial Number 980092, and that I delivered this radio to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police on the 10th day of March, 1942, and obtained a receipt therefor.

That I have made a most diligent search for the said receipt. I have not found the same and the sole reason for the non-production of the receipt is that it has been lost or accidentally destroyed.

That I, Toyoshi KAWATA, the owner, am therefore now entitled to the proceeds of the sale of my radio.
