

CHATELS: The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on June 4/42 and was evacuated on Sept. 16/42, declared chattels as shown on the Chattel Schedule on file, stored at House #18, Terra Nova C nnerfy. All the effects found at this house that could be identified as belonging to the above were disposed of at Steveston auctions for the net sum of \$70.59, and this sum was credited to the account of the above with this office. The account of the above was also credited with the sum of \$20.00 being the proceeds from sale of some lumber as noted on memo on file dated Dec. 7/43.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: According to information supplied to this office the above was the registered owner of a fishing vessel the "O.K/R.K" which was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$690.50, and this sum was paid to the above on May 21/42. Full details are given on Specified Articles Summary on file.

BANK ACCOUNT: The above declared a savings account in the Royal Bank of Canada in the sum of \$2000.00 and one in the Bank of Montreal, Hastings and Main Sts., Vancouver, in the sum of \$2600.00. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

The above, on Jan. 18/46, requested, through the Department of Labour, Japanese Division, that the ashes of Jirohachi KOYANAGI be shipped to him at Slocan City. These were accordingly shipped on Jan. 29/46 by Canadian Pacific Express.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
