
Please note that the above Japanese has been repatriated to Japan. The following is the status of his account with this Department, covering the repatriation transactions:

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

RE: Sawahara TASHIRO, Reg. No. Q5965

This file reveals that TASHIRO owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: Mr. TASHIRO made his declaration to the Custodian on June 4/42 and was evacuated on Aug. 25/42. He declared chattels as shown on Chattel Schedule on file at 526 East Cordova, where he resided prior to his evacuation.

Chattels were inventoried at this address by Custodian on Sept. 11/42 and removed to 992 Powell St. A list of this inventory was sent to Mr. TASHIRO asking him to confirm that these represented all his personal property in the protected area. He signed and returned this list on Nov. 14/42.

The kitchen stove declared by TASHIRO was not found by the Custodian. A kitchen table and cupboard were discarded. The following articles inventoried by the Custodian are missing:

3 beds	small cabinet	curtain stretcher
1 kitchen chair	chest	
office table	cabinet	

The contents of the boxes and cartons were sold at auction for the net sum of \$52.99 and this sum credited to the account of TASHIRO.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATES: He declared \$10.00 in War Savings Certificates in his own possession. These were not brought under the control of the Custodian.


When TASHIRO was repatriated on May 31/46 he did not take his free balance with him but requested that it be sent to Mrs. T. OKURA, 38 Classic Ave., Toronto, Ont. Since there are no claims on the file of Mrs. Tomi OKURA, file 12121, there does not seem to be any reason why this money should not be remitted to her.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.


