Re: E. C. Security Committee Investigation

As the E. C. Security Committee had accumulated sufficient evidence to justify the opening of the premises at 775 East Division Street, I contacted Mr. Williams of Harris & Williams, the legal representatives of the Association, and suggested to them that they should bring the key, and accompany the Custodian officials, and members of the E. C. Security Committee, to arrange identification of the chattels.

At 7:15 a.m. today we all met as arranged and Mr. Williams with the key attempted to open the front door. This proved impossible as there appeared to be some obstruction inside, quite apart from the bad condition of the lock on the door. Eventually we were able to gain entry through the rear door and were then able to understand why the front door could not be forced. There had indeed been the front door, and had placed large planks against the door, preventing the opening of it which would insure their unobstructed examination of all the chattels, most of which appeared to have been packed in boxes. The lock had been torn off the door and the contents removed and scattered over the floor, and piled up in a state of utter confusion, making almost impossible. Both Mr. Williams and the E. C. Security Committee representatives realized the futility of attempting to identify and separate the chattels, as the trunk was discarded.

Mr. Williams called in detectives who made a survey examination and left without making arrests. This particular location is the largest corner of the west district in Vancouver.

All chattels were eventually moved to our warehouse and sold by public auction.

Mr. Williams sent a representative who in company with our Mr. G. H. Davis spent about one week identifying the chattels on the basis of a list supplied by Mr. Williams. This identification was accomplished only with extreme difficulty.

Under the aforementioned circumstances, the Custodian can assume no responsibility for anything that may be missing.
