PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

File No. 10436

April 21, 1947.

RE: Shigeru SATO, Reg. No. 03647

This file reveals that SATO owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: SATO made his declaration to the Custodian on June 5/42 and was evacuated on Oct. 15/42. He declared no chattels on his original declaration, but Norris and MacLennan gave us a list of chattels left by SATO at the B. C. Purchaser's Co-Operative Ltd., 573 E. Hastings. Some boxes of merchandise, cases of shoyu and a sewing machine were removed by SATO and presumably taken with him according to report from Norris and MacLennan. Some were not found by the Custodian as listed on the Chattel Schedule. A wooden filing cabinet and oak type desk not included on list of goods left by SATO were sold and credited to him. These two items have now been transferred to Chattel Suspense Account. The balance of the goods found in his name were sold at auction in Van. auctions #14, 15 and 16, for the total net sum of \$49.50 and this sum credited to his account with the Custodian.

On Dec. 10/43 SATO sent in a Custodian release asking for shipment of 1 clothes bag containing clothes. There is no evidence that this was ever shipped or found by the Custodian.

The premises at 573 E. Hastings St. were broken into and goods stolen. As we had no complete inventory of goods at this address or what had been shipped from there, it was impossible to ascertain just exactly how much was missing. See memo on file dated Aug. 12/43 which gives a complete statement of condition in which chattels at this address were found by the Custodian.

MONEYS His account was credited with the sum of \$8.73, being a refund of 1% RECEIVABLE: wage deductions for the first six months of 1941.

WAR SAVINGS He declared eight \$5.00 War Savings Certificates. These were not CERTIFICATES: brought under the control of the Custodian.

LIFE He declared a policy with the Confederation Life Co. in the sum of INSURANCE: \$1500.00 and group insurance with Scot Bathgate Co. Ltd., for whom he had been a salesman. Neither of these policies came under the control of the Custodian.

MEMORANDUM

August 12th, 1943.

To: The File

FROM: Mr. C. E. Spain

RE: B. C. Purchasers Co-operative Association

As the B. C. Security Commission had accumulated sufficient Custodian releases to justify the opening of the premises at 573 East Hastings St., I telephoned Mr. McLennan of Morris & McLennan, the legal representative of the Association, and suggested to them that they should bring the key, and accompany the Custodian officials and members of the B.C. Security Commission, to arrange identification of chattels.

At 9:00 A.M. today we all met as arranged and Mr. McLennan with the key attempted to open the front door. This proved impossible as there appeared to be some obstruction inside, quite apart from the bad condition of the lock on the door. Eventually we were able to gain entry through the rear door and were then able to understand why the front door could not be forced. Thieves had entered by the front door, and had placed large planks against the door, preventing the opening of it which would insure their uninterrupted examination of all the chattels, most of which appeared to have been packed in boxes. The lids had been torn off the boxes and contents ransacked and scattered over the floor, and piled up in a state of utter confusion, making shipment impossible. Both Mr. McLennan and the B. C. Security Commission representative realized the futility of attempting to identify and separate the chattels, so the truck was dismissed.

Mr. McLennan called in detectives who made a cursory examination and left without making comments. This particular location is the hangout corner of the worst element in Vancouver.

All chattels were eventually moved to our warehouse and sold by public auction.

Mr. McLennan sent a representative who in company with our Mr. D. A. Smith, spent about one week identifying chattels on the basis of a list supplied by Mr. McLennan. This identification was accomplished only with extreme difficulty.

Under the aforementioned circumstances, the Custodian can assume no responsibility for anything that may be missing.
