We were not able to distinguish which effects belonged to the various owners since none of them were labelled but the total proceeds as per our enclosures have been provisionally credited to your account. Will you and your wife kindly contact your brother and his wife who are living at Lemon Creek and Mr. Tokuhei Masuda who is at the same place, and mutually arrange what to do with the money. A letter signed by yourself, Mr. Masao Edamura, and Mr. Tokuhei Masuda asking that the proceeds be paid to any one of you or divided in any other manner would be the best solution.
