Re: Jinshiro INAMOTO, Reg. No. 02772

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on June 8, 1942. He was evacuated on October 15, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a Ford truck in custody at Hastings Park. This truck was sold and the net proceeds of \$32.77 were credited to the account of this man.

He reported a debt of \$150.00 owing on rent to the Confederation Life Assn., Vancouver. We referred this debt to him in April, 1944 but received no reply.

The B. C. Telephone Co. filed a claim against this man for \$13.91. The Ferguson Transport Co. filed a claim against this man for \$7.50. These claims were referred to INAMOTO but we received no reply. We are again referring this claims to INAMOTO today.

There is a balance of \$32.77 standing to your credit with this office at the present time. This amount was received as the net proceeds from the sale of your Ford truck.

However, the B.C. Telephone Co. filed a claim against you for \$13.91 and the Ferguson Transport Co. filed a claim against you for \$7.50. In your declaration to the Custodian on June 8, 1942 you also reported owing \$150.00 to the Confederation Life Association for rent. We would appreciate your advising this office if the claims of the B.C. Telephone Co. and Ferguson Transport Co. are correct and if so we suggest you authorize this office to pay these claims from the balance standing to your credit. We could then either remit the balance of \$11.36 to the Confederation Life Association to be applied on your debt to them, or if this debt has been settled we could remit this amount to you.
