This file reveals that Mrs. SHINTANI owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: Mrs. SHINTANI made her declaration to the Custodian on June 9/42 and was evacuated on Sept. 17/42. She declared chattels as shown on Chattel Schedule on file left at 1603 Franklin St.

No chattels were found at this address belonging to her, but Mrs. MITSUGU, whose husband owned the property at 746 E. Cordova St., advise that some chattels which had been sold and credited to them, really belonged to Mrs. SHINTANI. The proceeds from sale of these goods in the sum of \$5.81 were therefore transferred to the account of Mrs. SHINTANI and this is her entire credit with the Custodian.

When Mrs. SHINTANI made her declaration to the Custodian on June 9/42 she declared chattels as shown on Chattel Schedule on file, at 1603 Franklin St. She states that if she can sell these goods she will do so, and if not, the key to the house will be given to the Custodian.

According to a memo on file from Mr. Spain, dated Nov. 7/44, the chattels at this address were left in care of the Mgr. B. W. Hodgson. He apparently sold some of these chattels to pay accounts he owed; gave some to employees of the Christian Spiritual Church in lieu of wages; and took some of them to his own apartment. He left town and his present whereabouts are unknown. The few chattels remaining at this address were moved to Willards auction and sold in Vancouver Auction #516. None of these however appeared to belong to Mrs. SHINTANI. Mr. SHINTANI declared chattels very similar to those declared by Mrs. SHINTANI. We wrote to him on Oct. and Nov., 1942, advising that we had found no chattels at 1603 Franklin St. belonging to him and asking him if he had left any chattels in the protected area. He did not reply to either of these letters. It would therefore appear that their chattels were sold prior to their evacuation.

Mrs. MITSUGU, whose husband owned the property at 746 E. Cordova St., advised that some chattels which had been sold and credited to them, really belonged to Mrs. SHINTANI. The proceeds from sale of these goods in the sum of \$5.81 were therefore transferred to the account of Mrs. SHINTANI and this is her only credit with the Custodian.

It is quite likely that these few items were all that Mrs. SHINTANI had not sold and that she had stored them with Mrs. MITSUGU.

Dear Madam:

When you and your husband made your declarations to the Custodian, you both declared chattels at 1603 Franklin Street. We presume these were the family chattels. On October 30, 1942, we advised your husband that no chattels had been found at this address in his name. Since he did not reply to this letter we assume that you and your husband carried out your intention of selling your chattels prior to your evacuation.

Mrs. MITSUGU, formerly of 746 E. Cordova Street, advised the Custodian that certain chattels which had been sold and credited to Mr. and Mrs. MITSUGU, really belonged to you. The proceeds from sale of these chattels in the sum of \$5.81 have therefore been transferred to your account.

As no assets or property of any kind belonging to you now remain under the control of the Custodian, we are therefore closing your account and your file.

All chattels remaining at the above address were moved to Willards Auction room where they were included in Vancouver Auction #516.

The chattels were entrusted to the care of the Rev. B. W. Hodgson who decamped from Vancouver sometime ago, and who is now supposed to be somewhere in Eastern Canada. He left unpaid accounts and sold some of the Japanese chattels to the cleaning staff of the Christian Spiritual Church in lieu of payment of wages. I also understand that he sold a lot of the chattels in Vancouver, and used some articles for fuel.

There was also a report that he had moved some chattels to his apartment located somewhere on Seymour or Columbia streets. This is now under further investigation.

If anything is discovered, I shall make a supplementary report.
