At the time I was reporting my chattels at the Custodian I mentioned why I was leaving same and what arrangements were to be made in case of a sale of the goods. I wish you would make a closer check on the report I made to the Custodian at time of registration.

Do you think that I would go to the trouble of reporting and making arrangements for my chattels, if I had already sold them? Poor as I am I'm not low enough to make a deal on good faith, then, break it behind your back.

I really feel dissappointed at the procedure your office is taking regarding the safe-guarding of my chattels. First you send me a list checked by your office which was only half of my goods, nextyou write telling me that some of the people are using some, lastly you say that my firmer landlord have already bought all my chattels. Upon investigation you will find that there is no Bill of Sale for these goods that he says he bought. Trusting that you will give more closer attention hereafter.
