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

On further investigation it was found that this debt was owed to the Union Fish Co. Ltd. (Int.124), in the amount of \$15.40, which is being handled by P. S. Ross & Sons. A cheque for \$2.79, being the total funds in this Evacuee's account has been forwarded to P. S. Ross & Sons Limited with an explanation that these are the total funds available in this account.

No further action regarding the payment of the balance of this account is being taken by the Custodian.
