





The above, who registered with the Custodian on June 9/42 and was evacuated Oct. 26/42, signed a yellow "no property" card stating that she had no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of British Columbia.

We received a cheque from the Crown Life Insurance Co. in favour of the above in the sum of \$32.15 on Dec. 30/43, being the cash surrender value of the bonus additions under Policy No. 156,162. This cheque was remitted to the above by this office on Jan. 11/44.

The above returned a cheque we had sent to her in the sum of \$12.26, being the cash value of War Savings Certificates she had left in our possession, and asked us to keep this sum in her account with the Custodian. This is her only credit balance.

The file reveals no claims against the above.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
