In the matter of the Bankruptcy of Shinichi Kawada and Eigoro Hiraga, trading as Kawada Box Co., Vancouver, B.C.

The Company made a voluntary assignment in Bankruptcy on Jan. 16/42 and at the statutory meeting of Creditors The Canadian Credit Men's Trust Association Ltd. were appointed Trustee (File 13110).

After due process the Custodian received Statement of Receipts and disbursements in the above connection from the Trustee, dated Aug. 11, 1943 showing a total amount available for distribution of \$4,093.82. In accordance with the regulations of the Bankruptcy Act, it is necessary that the trustee notify each creditor by registered mail of the intention to apply for discharge. As you will remember, the above company made an assignment in January 1942, when we were appointed trustee at the statutory meeting. The assets were offered for sale as a going concern and the stock, machinery and equipment sold to Mr. W. Charlie Wong for \$3,500.00. We were also successful in disposing of the Dodge car for \$1,025.00, which was considered a satisfactory price.

Difficulty was experienced in obtaining information from the principals of the Company with respect to several features in connection with the business and the creditors' claims as the Japanese were evacuated from the Coast territory shortly after the affairs were placed in our hands. In addition certain of the Company's records were kept in Japanese. However, we believe that all the available assets have been realized and you will note from the statement of receipts and disbursements attached that there will be a dividend of 17½% available in respect of the ordinary claims.

We are applying for our discharge as per copy of notice enclosed and the dividend in question will be distributed in due course as outlined therein.

We beg to acknowledge receipt of yours of the 18th enclosing claim of Miss Sadako Isoshima against the above estate for \$28.83. Unfortunately there is no statement attached to the claim to show that it is a wage claim and the dates between which the wages were earned. According to our information these wages were not earned within the three months prior to the bankruptcy which would entitle them to preference under bankruptcy rules.

As matters now stand we are prepared to rank this claim as ordinary which will receive a dividend in due course and which we estimate will be around 15%.

With regard to the reference in your letter that all wage claims had been paid we have to advise that as far as we know all the preferred wage claims have been paid. Any others must be of the same classification as that of Miss Isoshima, having been incurred prior to the preferred period.

Re: Kawade Box Company.

We read your further memo of the 26th instant; also communication from the Canadian Credit Men's Trust Association Limited and note that they have been advised that it is now in order for them to eliminate certain creditors.

We have already informed you that letters have been addressed to the Camp Commandant to parade Tsugio SHIMIZU and Yoshitaka TERANISHI in order to find out if any money is due these internees and we would be obliged if you would so advise the Canadian Credit Men's Trust Association when you reply to their communication of the 15th instant.

It would appear that the provisions of the Consolidated Regulations Respecting Trading With The Enemy (1939) have been overlooked by the solicitor and it might be well for you to direct their attention to the following:

"No property vested in the Custodian shall be forfeited for default in doing any act or making any payment in respect thereof, or attached, seized or taken under any legal process or any distress, or foreclosed, or sold under any mortgage, lien, pledge or charge, or sold for any tax or assessment.
(P.C. 2512, R. 44 Am.)"

All periods of prescription or limitations of right of action, whether they began to run before or after the commencement of the present war, shall be treated in Canada, so far as regards relations between persons who are not enemies under these Regulations and enemies, as having been suspended during the present war. (P.C. 2512, R. 47 Am.)"

"(1) The onus of proof in every instance shall rest upon the person who asserts that he or any property claimed or held by him is not within the provisions of these Regulations.

→ (P.C. 2512 R. 55 (1) Am.)

(2) All evidence submitted to the Custodian shall become the property of the Custodian and may be retained by him (New)"

We would appreciate your sending us copies of your letter for our files. We return the Canadian Credit Men's Trust Association letter of 15th instant to which Notice is attached and we would point out that this is the first time that such notice has been received by this Department representing the internee interest if any

In reply to yours of the 8th, the above firm made an assignment in bankruptcy on January 16th 1942 and at the Statutory meeting we were appointed Trustee and following named as Inspectors:

They operated a box factory at 425 Alexander Street and subsequently this was sold to a Chinese group operating under the name of the Fraser Box Company, at the price of \$3500.00, subject to certain adjustments with regard to the quantity of material on hand. Other assets consisted of a Dodge car and book accounts, the total realised being \$4861.75.

At the present time our final statement of receipts and disbursements is under preparation and will be forwarded to the Superintendent of Bankruptcy in the near future.

For your information we enclose a list of the creditors which was sent out at the time of the assignment, and have placed a red check mark against the names of those creditors who have not filed claims, these being mostly Japanese.. Notice of the bankruptcy was given to these parties and on June 9th last the statutory notice provided under the Bankruptcy Act requesting that claims be filed within thirty days was sent to these creditors and as they did not

file claim within the period they are automatically debarred as creditors. If you have any comment to make with regard to these particular claims please advise us as soon as possible, as we wish to close out the estate at as early a date as possible. We estimate that the dividend will be approximately 17%.

All the claims filed are against the partnership. We have no claims against either of the partners personally, nor did we have control of any personal assets. The list of creditors herewith enclosed shows T. Omoto as a personal claim but after investigation this was changed to a claim against the partnership. We enclose the statement of assets and liabilities as presented at the time of the bankruptcy.

Those Japanese who were entitled to wage claims have already been paid their claims in full.


