

We wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter of February 15th. On checking up the matter we find that property belonging to Mr. Konishi at Port Moody, being Lots 9 and 10, Block 48, District Lot 347, was recently rented for one year from January 11, 1943 at 5.00 per month.

Mr. Konishi's account in this office at the present time shows a credit balance of \$6.00, being rental payment for January.

With reference to Sun Life Policy 2300738 in the name of Kunizo Konishi, we have been advised by the Sun Life Assurance Company that there is an amount of \$63.73 owing on this policy as at February 28th. At present it is not possible for us to take care of this payment.

Our policy with respect to life insurance on the lives of evacuee Japanese persons is that if they declare their life insurance or send their policies to this office, we will pay premiums from time to time if requested to do so by the Policyholder, and of course, providing that there are funds here standing to their credit and that other outstanding claims and expenses, if any, in connection with maintaining their property have been looked after.
