The Royal Columbian Hospital seemed to think that Mr. Shusai SASAKI, father of Miyo SASAKI, should assume the responsibility of paying this account. Mr. Shusai disclaimed responsibility as his daughter was over 21 years of age at the time she was discharged from the Hospital. The Hospital have been advised by us in two different letters that we would make no effort to collect this account. Mr. Shusai SASAKI has no funds with the Custodian and Miss SASAKI has a credit of \$3.46.

The Provincial Board of Health have not been written to regarding this claim, but we are writing to them today advising that we will take no steps towards collecting this account.



At the present time we have approximately \$10,798.82 outstanding against Japanese for hospitalization. Included in this is an account of \$2596.65 for Miss Miyo Sasaki, (Father, Shyski Sasaki) on which no payment has been made to date.

As the Japanese are moving from place to place, and it is likely a great many of them will be deported, we are anxious to know as to what is being done to protect our interests.

We have now received your answer to our letter of the 1st ult., but it does not clearly dispose of SASAKI's reply to us as quoted therein. However, as the father denies responsibility for the daughter's account, and as you say the daughter was of age at the time, it does not appear that we can do more toward the collection or settlement of this claim.
