MEMORANDUM

TO: MR. K. W. WRIGHT
FROM: MR. G. H. PEERS

RE: Kazu IZUMI
Shinya YOSHIDA

The Evacuee, Shinya YOSHIDA, is being repatriated to Japan, and Mr. Alexander states that his name is included in the final list received on August 26th, from Mr. G. W. McPherson.

Yoshida asks that the balance, at present to his credit, amounting to \$47.09, be paid to Miss Kazuko IZUMI, and also when Lots 20 and 21, Block 19, D.L. 328, being Vacant Lots on South West Marine Drive, are sold, that the proceeds be paid to Kazuko IZUMI. He also requests that certain of his furniture be given to her on her marriage, but he does not give a list of the items.

Miss Izumi is aged 24 and Mr. Yoshida states she is the daughter of a relative and has lived with his family since babyhood, although she was not legally adopted. He also states that "her marriage is uncertain at least for the time being".

When the repatriate has definitely sailed for Japan, this matter should be given consideration.

Re: Your File No. 10529

On suggestion made through the Spanish Consul-General, Montreal, myself and my wife are to be repatriated to Japan in a very near future in exchange with Canadian Nationals. However, Kazuko Izumi, a girl of my relative will, although she has been brought up in my family since her babyhood as if she has been fostered to us, remain in this country. Due to this circumstance, I feel it my duty within my power to see that she be given some money as her living expenses to carry on this most trying period.

Now therefore, with further reference to my letter of July 21st, to which you have kindly remitted me on account \$100.00 covering partially the money realized from the sale of my car, I beg to request you to have the balance paid to Kazuko Izumi, at the above address. Also when my property, Lots 20 and 21, Block 19, D.L. 328 on South East Marine Drive is sold, as no doubt that there was an offer made some time ago to which I already agreed with you, I wish to have the money available to her as well.

And further, besides her personal effects left at my house at Steveston, B. C., I have promised to give her, upon her marriage, certain household goods and furnitures. But, because of our evacuation from Steveston, this promise was never carried out, her marriage uncertain for at least the time being, and some of these goods were rented to Mr. Remisen under lease for the duration of the war. I would be very much obliged, with your kind assistance, if this promise be fulfilled at any time when she marry.

Kindly give these matters your special considerations
and oblige.
