Certificate of Title No. 176015-E was delivered to the purchaser by registered mail on October 4. 1944.

Owing to the death of Toranosuke Kadohama on July 27, 1944, it appears that no statement of the transaction was sent to either Japanese.

The Accounting Department was requested to freese the funds on December 5, 1944.

The file reveals that Toranosuke Kadohama died on July 27, 1944, at Calgary, Alberta.
