This lady appears to have been most business-like in her dealings as far as her effects are concerned and if every evacuee were as punctilious, life would be very easy for the Protection Department.

It seems likely from the file that everything declared on the "JP" was removed by her either on February 5th, 1943, or on December 3rd, 1943. However, I notice some marks against the inventory attached to the Release received under the second date and it might be that these items which are mostly fairly bulky, have been left on the premises. I am asking Mr. Spain to check this.

It appears that the items left at Knight Inlet which were to have been brought down to Vancouver, were never shipped -- see letter of February 16th, 1943. Mr. Spain might look into this at the same time.

Finally, from letter of February 5th, 1943, it appears that Mrs. Tatsuyo Matsumoto, file 10611, left some things here. She seems to have removed these in exactly the same way, but here again there are some articles marked on the enclosure to the Release dated December 3rd which may possibly be still on the premises and I am asking Mr. Spain to check this at the same time.
