Dear Sir: See Policy No. 108720646 - Prudential Ins. Co.

We enclose cheque for \$36.43 recently to hand from The Prudential Insurance Company of America relating to the above Policy. The cheque is made out to Kiyochi KITAGAWA and Tsungyan KITAGAWA, but according to our records the second name should be "Tsunya" KITAGAWA, Registration No. 09465 (our file No. 10670).

We gather that Tsunya Kitagawa is your father and in the circumstances it may be necessary for you to have your father endorse the cheque, using the name on the cheque (Tsunyan) instead of Tsunya. You, of course, will have to endorse this cheque on the back also, as indicated. We do not think there will be any difficulty about cashing the cheque if the above is done, but if there are objections then the only thing to do is for you to return the cheque to the Prudential Insurance Company of America, Newark, New Jersey, with a letter, enclosing a copy of this letter (extra copy of which is attached for this purpose) and for you to request them to issue a new cheque with the correct name of Tsunya Kitagawa.

In any event, please acknowledge safe receipt of the enclosed cheque, and oblige.

A further extra copy of this letter is attached in case you would like to be kept as a record by your father.
