With reference to the claim which your company has lodged with the Custodian against the above named Japanese, we wrote to KANDA and he has replied as follows:

"With reference to your letter of the 19th January regarding the claim of B.C. Packers Limited for the amount \$124.79, I beg to state that the claim is believed to be correct.

Now, regarding the payment for this debt, I wish to say that it is impossible to do any thing at the present owing to only a limited small earning which is hardly able to maintain my living.

When the time come that I will be in the Coast and engage in fishing again, I will do my best to repay the debt."

As he has no funds standing to his credit with the Custodian we are afraid we cannot do anything further to assist you for the time being in collecting this account. Your claim, however, has been filed against him, and should any funds come to hand at some future date it will receive the necessary attention.
