

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Zenichi NISHIMURA, Reg. No. 01652

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on June 16, 1942. He was evacuated on June 19, 1942.

In his declaration he reported only his Crown Life Insurance policy, which was in his own possession. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

On August 6, 1942, however, a messenger acting for Mr. Kisaku HAYASHI, owner of the premises at 522 Powell Street, requested that a large box and a small box left there by Mr. Zenichi NISHIMURA be removed at once. These boxes were removed to 992 Powell Street, and on September 25, 1942, Zenichi NISHIMURA signed statement that these were all the chattels belonging to him in the protected area. Goods, identified as belonging to this man, and apparently the contents of the two boxes, were sold at Vancouver Auctions 32 and 34. The net proceeds, amounting to \$36.89, has been credited to his account.

On March 2, 1943, NISHIMURA signed Custodian Release requesting shipment to himself of two trunks and a box of kitchenware left at 5996 Marine Street, Vancouver, B. C. On March 26, 1943, we informed the B. C. Security Commission that Mrs. Brydnildsen, of 5996 Marine would deliver these to the Commission for shipment. It is assumed that shipment was made.

The sum of \$1.44 was credited to this account as refund of 1% wage deduction for 1941. Although the house number given on file in regard to this credit is not that of Zenichi NISHIMURA, File 10761, he is the only Zenichi NISHIMURA in our records revealed as a former resident of Powell Street. This small credit is therefore being released along with his chattel money.

The Real Property referred to in this file, as well as the liabilities referred to in this file, concern another man of the same name, Zenichi NISHIMURA, File 11744, now repatriated to Japan.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.
