GENERAL SUMMARY

RE: Miss Kazuko KAGAWA, Reg. No. 01959

Miss KAGAWA made her declaration to the Custodian on June 17/42 and was evacuated on June 30/42.

She declared one Singer electric sewing machine stored at Bekins Storage in Vancouver. On April 23/43 she sent in a Custodian Release asking for shipment of this machine. We wrote to Bekins on May 18/43 giving them permission to make this shipment.

She declared the sum of \$77.00 owing to her by the Koushinkia Club (Credit Union), the president being Mr. NIMI of 331 Powell St. On checking his file, No. 10711, he states in his letter of Feb. 16/43 that Miss KAGAWA must be in error as the Credit Union was dissolved in Jan. 1942, and the surplus money divided between the members.


She declared one \$50.00 Victory bond in her own possession. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.
