This file reveals that Mrs. Takei TATEBE owned no real property in any protected are of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

Mrs. TATEBE made her declaration to the Custodian on June 17/42 and was evacuated on June 29/42. She declared chattels as shown on CHATTELS: Chattel Schedule on file left at the church at 715 W. 7th Ave.

No chattels were removed from this church in her name but a large quantity of chattels was removed and listed as "Unidentifiable". From this list, chattels corresponding to those declared by Mrs. TATEBE were transferred to her file. These were sold for the net sum of \$18.32 and this sum credited to her account with the Custodian.

Mrs. TATEBE had also declared a box of Xmas decorations and some Japa nese dolls left in care of Mrs. TANAKA of 117 W. 6th Ave. I have checked the files of both Mr. and Mrs. TANAKA, formerly of this address, and no chattels are declared by them and none found by the Custodian belonging to them. It would therefore appear that Mrs. TANAKA must have either disposed of them or taken them with her when she was evacuated.

WAR SAVINGS Mrs. TATEBE declared one \$5.00 War Savings Certificate in the name of CERTIFICATES: her son. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.
