With reference to your letter of September 5th, on taking up this matter with the Collector of Institutional Revenue he writes us as follows:

"Please be advised that in view of the circumstances outlined, the Department is willing to forego the claim for maintenance in this case and allow the balance of \$38.96 to be paid to the Evacuee."

The claim of \$1467.00 for expenses incurred in connection with the hospitalization of your late husband having been withdrawn, we are now able to forward you a cheque for \$38.96, the amount standing to the credit of your account.

We have expressed on your behalf to the Collector of Institutional Revenue appreciation for the action taken in this matter.

There being nothing to account to you in regard to real or personal property your account and file are now being closed.
