In view of the fact that this party was released from the internment camp and was subsequently employed by Canada Packers, I do not think the Custodian should interfere in any way with the administration of his estate but assume that the Public Prustee in Toronto will administer the estate and will recognise the request of the beneficiaries to pay \$200,00 to the British Columbia Security Commission. I think we should stay clear, if possible, of matters of this kind. I can appreciate that you may consider that while this party was originally interned, possible in British Columbia, he was also an evacues but it does not appear that property rights he had in a group insurance could be considered in any sense of the word to be property in the Protected Area because It did not even exist at the time of his interment or evacuation.
