PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

RE: Hayanojo YOSHIMUCHI, Reg. No. 10352

This file reveals that YOSHIMUCHI owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS:

YOSHIMUCHI registered with the Custodian on June 18/42 and was evacuated on June 29/42. He signed a yellow "No property" card stating he owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of B.C.


However we found on Int. File 448, a memo signed by S. TASHIRO, Minister of the Tenrikyo Canada Church, 526 E. Cordova St., to the effect that Hayanojo YOSHIMUCHI had left a box containing china and glassware at this church. Goods as shown on Chattel Schedule were inventoried at 526 E. Cordova in the name of YOSHIMUCHI. The boxes and cartons contained dishes, glassware and Xmas decorations and these were sold at auction for the net sum of \$6.89 and this sum credited to the account of YOSHIMUCHI. The trunk inventoried in his name is missing.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
