1. That I owned 1 Westinghouse mantel radio, Model #54, Serial No. 119390, and that I delivered this radio to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, their Report No. 708, on the 21st of April, 1942 and did not obtain a receipt therefor.

2. Further, in case I did receive a receipt, I made a most diligent search for same.

I have not found a receipt and the sole reason for the non-production of same is that I either did not receive one, or it has been lost or accidentally destroyed.

3. That, I, Stella KIROMA, the owner, am therefore entitled to the proceeds of the sale of my radio.
